- *Excerpt from 2018 Bylaws ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS AND DUTIES.*
  - A)  
President - shall have general supervision of the business of the club. Shall preside over and conduct orderly meetings of the BBSC and executive board. Coordinates the work of officers and committees . Shall sign all contracts and other instruments in the name of BBSC.
  - B) Vice  
President - to assist the President. To assume the President's responsibility in the event of the President's absence. Chair the activities committee. Responsible for the calendar of events and trail boss duties.
  - C)  
Secretary - to record the minutes of BBSC meetings and to read and present them at the next regular meeting. To appoint an alternate in the event of their absence from a meeting. To complete and send out cards and/or flowers to ill members and their families as designated by the President. To send out "thank you" letters to sponsors and to special speakers/guests. Is responsible for recording the results of all votes.
  - D)  
Treasurer- to keep all financial records of the BBSC. Collect annual dues and initiation fees. Receive and dispense BBSC funds as authorized by the membership and the executive board. It is the treasurer's responsibility to present a detailed financial report of the previous month's financial activity in the form of a hard copy to be viewed by the membership and to be published with the minutes of the meeting.
  - E)  
Publicity Chairman- arrange for all BBSC publicity by informing local papers, radio stations and other media of public BBSC activities. To stimulate interest in the BBSC. To prepare and distribute posters, etc. To keep a file of all publicity relating to BBSC and its activities.
