The choice of items that the members want is open to discussion. This is just a start based on what the members have liked in the past.

  - The logo for all items is on the back rather than the front. I personally like this better and it can be larger. But again open to discussion.
  - I do not have prices as they depend on the quantity ordered. What I CAN tell you is that if we place it as a GROUP order we set a minimum number of pieces for the ENTIRE order, for example 50. And it does not matter how many of each as long as the total is 50. Each person can order and pay for their own items and it is shipped directly to you. The group order must use the same logo on all items and in the same location. If desired we could have a smaller version of the logo on the front too.
